

Free Child Care Services When You Need to Be at Work

NYC Health + Hospitals is offering **free** child care services (for dependents 0-12 years of age) to NYC Health + Hospitals' workforce (employees, affiliate and temporary staff) during the COVID-19 emergency response. Apply for a number of options to access screened care providers to meet your needs:

- Register to have your child attend a [NYC Department of Education's Regional Enrichment Center \(REC\)](#) in over 100 New York City locations. The centers are open 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday - Friday.
- Apply to a network of screened **child care centers** and **in-home** caregivers through Bright Horizons. Complete the [Childcare Application Form](#). Once you apply, you will receive an email confirmation, and instructions on what you need to do to access Bright Horizons services.

Employees also have free access to [Sittercity.com](#), a database to find child care providers in their neighborhood. Employees are responsible for covering the costs of services offered through the Sittercity website.
