

## Free Child Care Services When You Need to Be at Work

NYC Health + Hospitals is offering **free** child care services (for dependents 0-12 years of age) to NYC Health + Hospitals' workforce (employees, affiliate and temporary staff) during the COVID-19 emergency response. Apply for a number of options to access screened care providers to meet your needs:

- Register to have your child attend a <u>NYC Department of Education's</u>
  <u>Regional Enrichment Center (REC)</u> in over 100 New York City
  locations. The centers are open 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday Friday.
- Apply to a network of screened child care centers and in-home caregivers through Bright Horizons. Complete the <u>Childcare Application</u> <u>Form</u>. Once you apply, you will receive an email confirmation, and instructions on what you need to do to access Bright Horizons services.

Employees also have free access to <u>Sittercity.com</u>, a database to find child care providers in their neighborhood. Employees are <u>responsible for covering the</u> costs of services offered through the Sittercity website.
