

## COVID-19 Infection & Isolation Order

COVID-19 (confirmed) & COVID-19 (rule out) are now available for clinicians to choose as infection options. The new isolation order for COVID-19 is also available for providers to order.

### Try It Out:

Click the patient header to add infection COVID-19:

1. Click **Isolation** in the patient header to open up Infections and Isolation activity. Then type “covid-19” in the search bar, you will see two options as shown in the screenshot below. Choose the appropriate infection.

Airborne and Contact and Eye Protection Isolation Instructions

- Please post this Airborne + Contact + Eye Protection [Sign](#) on the patient door
- Limit visitors
- Visitors must report to the nursing station before entering this room
- Clean hands when entering and exiting the room
- Healthcare workers: N95 respirator, face shield, gown & gloves
- Visitors: Surgical Facemask, face shield, gown & gloves
- Keep the door closed at all times
- Disinfect shared patient equipment after use with approved disinfectant following manufacturer's recommendations

**Airborne and Contact and Eye Protection precautions** are necessary to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
