

Quarantine Smartphrase

This tipsheet will show inpatient providers how to access a new Quarantine SmartPhrase that is to be used when discharging a patient from the hospital. Through this SmartPhrase the provider has the ability to give Home/Self Quarantine Instructions to the patient.

Try It Out:

1. Click on the Discharge Navigator on the left hand side of your screen.
2. Scroll down to the **Patient Instructions** section.
3. Begin typing **“.QUARANTINE”** into the body of the Patient Instructions section. The smart phrase window will appear as you begin typing.
4. From the smart phrase window, double click your selection to pull this into the text box.

Stay home except to get medical care

People who are mildly ill with COVID-19 are able to isolate at home during their illness. You should restrict activities outside your home, except for getting medical care. Do not go to work, school, or public areas. Avoid using public transportation, ride-sharing, or taxis.

Separate yourself from other people and animals in your home

People: As much as possible, you should stay in a specific room and away from other people in your home. Also, you should use a separate bathroom, if available.
