NYC Health + Hospitals Post Acute Care Facilities COVID-19 Visitation Policy

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The following policy is in effect temporarily to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

NYC Health + Hospitals Post Acute Care facilities will be *limiting* visitations to nursing home residents. Limiting means that individuals should not be allowed to come into the facility, except for certain situations, such as end-of-life situations or when a visitor is essential for the resident's emotional well-being and care.

NYC Health + Hospitals Post Acute Care Facilities will *actively screen* and *restrict/not allow* visitation by those who meet the following criteria:

- Signs or symptoms of a respiratory infection, such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat.
- In the last 14 days, has had contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, or under investigation for COVID-19, or are ill with respiratory illness.
- International travel within the last 14 days to countries with sustained community transmission.
- *Residing in a community where community-based spread of COVID-19 is occurring.*
- 12 years or younger.
