## **Vaccines Now Available to ALL Who Provide Care to Admitted Patients with COVID-19**

Effective immediately, COVID-19 vaccines are now available to all **clinical** and **non-clinical** health care workers in the following areas:

- **Any area of the hospital which provides care to admitted patients with COVID-19 (NEW)**
- **Emergency Departments**
- **Intensive Care Units**
- **Medical/Surgical Units**
- **Step Down Units**
- **Areas performing aerosol-generating procedures, including Anesthesia**
- **Pulmonary Function Test Labs**
- **Bronchoscopy Suites**
- **Endoscopy Suites**

Eligible staff include employees, affiliate staff, house staff, volunteers, or vendor staff who are nurses, providers, environmental services workers, food service workers, clerks and any others who work in these high-risk areas.

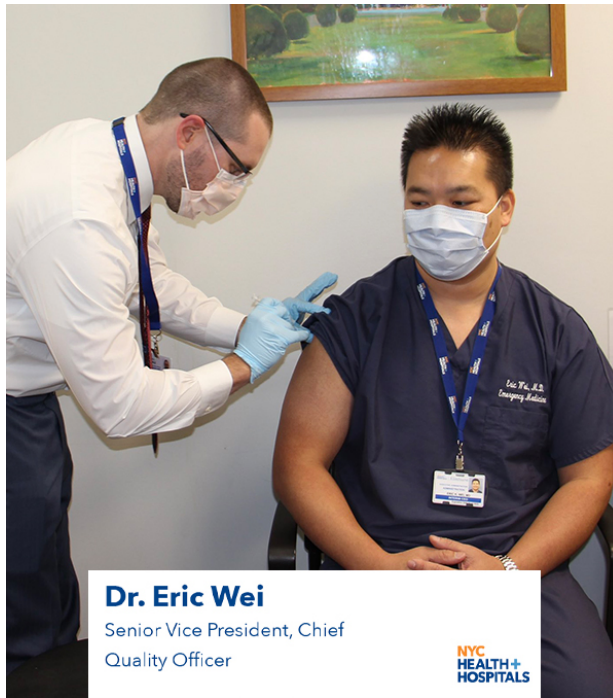
