Patient-Facing Staff from NYC Test & Trace, Community Care and Central Office Now Eligible



Eligibility has been further expanded to all clinical and non-clinical healthcare workers who work in any NYC Health + Hospitals acute care hospital, Gotham Health Center or NYC Test & Trace location where community testing, treatment, support or outreach to patients or clients with COVID-19 is performed.

In addition, eligibility is now open to <u>any</u> NYC Health + Hospitals workforce member working in our hospitals, clinics, testing sites, or seeing patients in the community. Also eligible are Community Care staff that see patients at a hotel or home. Central Office staff who support the provision of care in our facilities and who must come into work part-time or full-time are also now eligible for vaccination.
