Vaccines Now Available to New Yorkers 75 and Older, Unaffiliated Providers, Essential Workers

NYC Health + Hospitals will now offer COVID-19 vaccines to an expanded group of New Yorkers – Groups 1A and 1B, as determined by New York State. We will continue to prioritize vaccinations to our own workforce. The new eligible groups include:

- Health care workers from the community non NYC Health + Hospitals providers
- New Yorkers 75 and older
- Teachers and other education workers
- Childcare workers
- First responders
- Public safety workers
- Public transit workers

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Thousands Starting to Get Their Second Dose

Both the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines require a second dose. Many of our first round of NYC Vax Champs across NYC Health + Hospitals are beginning to get their second dose. Your second dose must be the same brand as your first dose and has to be administered at the same facility where you received the first dose.
