Don't Wait – Get Your Vaccine this Week!

Governor Cuomo announced last Friday that hospitals in New York will be given one last week to prioritize workers and, then, the State could shift doses for health system employees to the newly eligible groups for vaccine. While vaccine will continue to be available to all NYC Health + Hospitals employees, supplies will remain limited and there will be a growing population of New Yorkers eligible to receive the vaccine. Eligibility Will Extend to People with Comorbidities Feb 15

Starting Monday, February 15, people with comorbidities – which include conditions such as diabetes, heart disease, cancer, obesity and HIV – will become eligible for COVID-19 vaccine in New York.
