

## **COVID Transfer Smartphrase**

This tip sheet will show inpatient providers how to access a new COVID-19 specific SmartPhrase that is to standardize the transfer language, and give providers the ability to document whether the patient or patient representative has agreed or disagreed to the transfer.

## Try It Out:

- 1. Within the body of your note, begin typing ".COVIDTRANSFER". The smart phrase window will appear as you begin typing.
- 2. From the smart phrase window, double click your selection to pull this into the text box.

4. Press "**F2**", on your keyboard, to highlight the SmartList in your note. Using your mouse, **left-click** to select one of the options and **right-**click to pull it into your note.
