

Mobile Test to Treat

NO-COST, NO ID, NO INSURANCE, same-day, on-site COVID-19 treatment available

Select **NYC Test + Trace Corps** mobile testing units now offer COVID-19 treatment screenings and prescriptions to patients who test positive for the virus. The medication is in pill form, is prescribed by a healthcare provider at the mobile unit, and is provided on-site - all **at no cost** to patients. Treatment can prevent severe illness and in many cases hospitalization

How it works:

- You are administered a no-cost Rapid Antigen COVID-19 test
- Results are available in under a half hour
- If you test positive, you will be immediately connected to a healthcare provider on-site
- The provider will review your medical history, any medications you're currently on, and pre-existing conditions that may complicate your diagnosis to determine eligibility.
- If you are eligible and choose to receive the COVID-19 antiviral treatment, the provider will write a prescription on-site.
- That prescription is dispensed to you at the mobile unit, for you to take at home.

What is the treatment?

The antiviral treatment is a pill, taken twice-a-day for five days.

Who is eligible for COVID-19 treatment?

Patients who are most at-risk for moderate to severe COVID-19 and are 12+, and test positive for the virus at an NYC HHC mobile unit that offers COVID-19 antiviral treatment are eligible. Insurance is not required, and antiviral treatment is dispensed at no-cost to patients.

Can I receive treatment if I test positive at home?

No. For clinical and safety reasons, patients are required to be tested in the mobile unit in order to consult with the on-site clinician. If you tested positive at home, you can re-test with the unit OR call 212-COVID19 to be screened for eligibility by virtual express care.

Where will these mobile units be?

Testing + Treatment units will be located all around the city, including at parks and at community-based organizations. A full list of sites will be updated weekly at nyc.gov/covidtest.
