Hand Hygiene

- + Wash hands or use alcohol-based foam before and after patient contact
- + Use soap & water if hands are visibly soiled



Patient Placement:

- + Private room
- + Door must remain closed



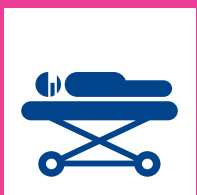
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- + As advised by Infection Control
- + In case of emergencies wear:
 - Face shield
 - Surgical Mask
 - Impervious gown
 - Double gloves (extended cuff)



Patient Care Equipment and Devices

- + Use single use disposable equipment
- + Disinfect shared equipment after use with approved disinfectant following manufacturer's recommendations



Patient Transport

- + Contact patient's physician for authorization
- + Patient should wear a surgical face mask

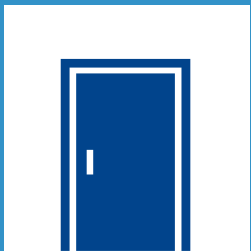

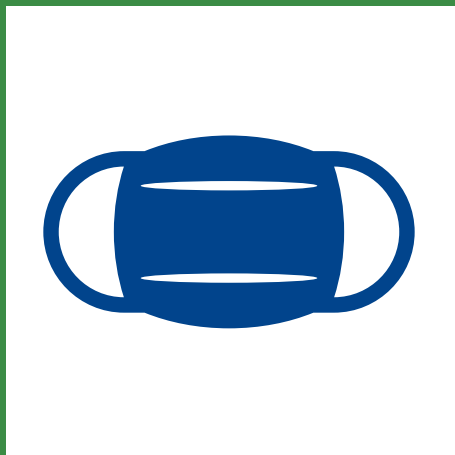

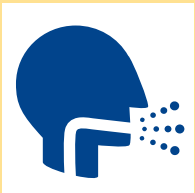
Hand Hygiene

- + Routinely perform hand hygiene with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer before entering and exiting patients' rooms, touching surfaces and before donning gloves



PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

- + Wear gloves, gowns and protective eye wear/face shield before touching body fluids, mucous, membranes, and non-intact skin as necessary based on scenario, as well as for procedures that cause splashes or sprays of body fluids
- + Remove and discard PPE upon exiting room/area. Perform hand hygiene upon exiting



Respiratory Etiquette

- + Cover mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing
- + Cough or sneeze into elbow if tissues are not available
- + Wash hands with soap and water or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer



Patient Care Equipment and Devices

- + Disinfect equipment after each patient use with approved disinfectant
- + Follow manufacturer's recommendations for contact time

Environmental Sanitation/Disinfection

- + Clean environment and equipment with hospital approved disinfectant
- + Follow manufacturer's recommendations for contact time



Safe Injection Practices

- + Maintain aseptic technique during preparation and administration of injectable medications
- + Needles and syringes are single use devices
- + Do not administer medications from a single dose vial or IV bag to multiple patients
- + Limit the use of multi-dose vials and dedicate them to a single patient whenever possible
- + Wear mask when performing lumbar puncture

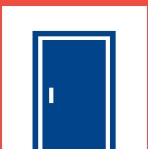

In addition to Standard Precautions

All Visitors and staff must report to the nurses station before entering this room

Patient Transport

- + Limited to medically essential purposes that cannot otherwise be addressed at the bedside
- + Patient must wear a mask throughout the transport
- + Notify receiving area prior commencing the transport
