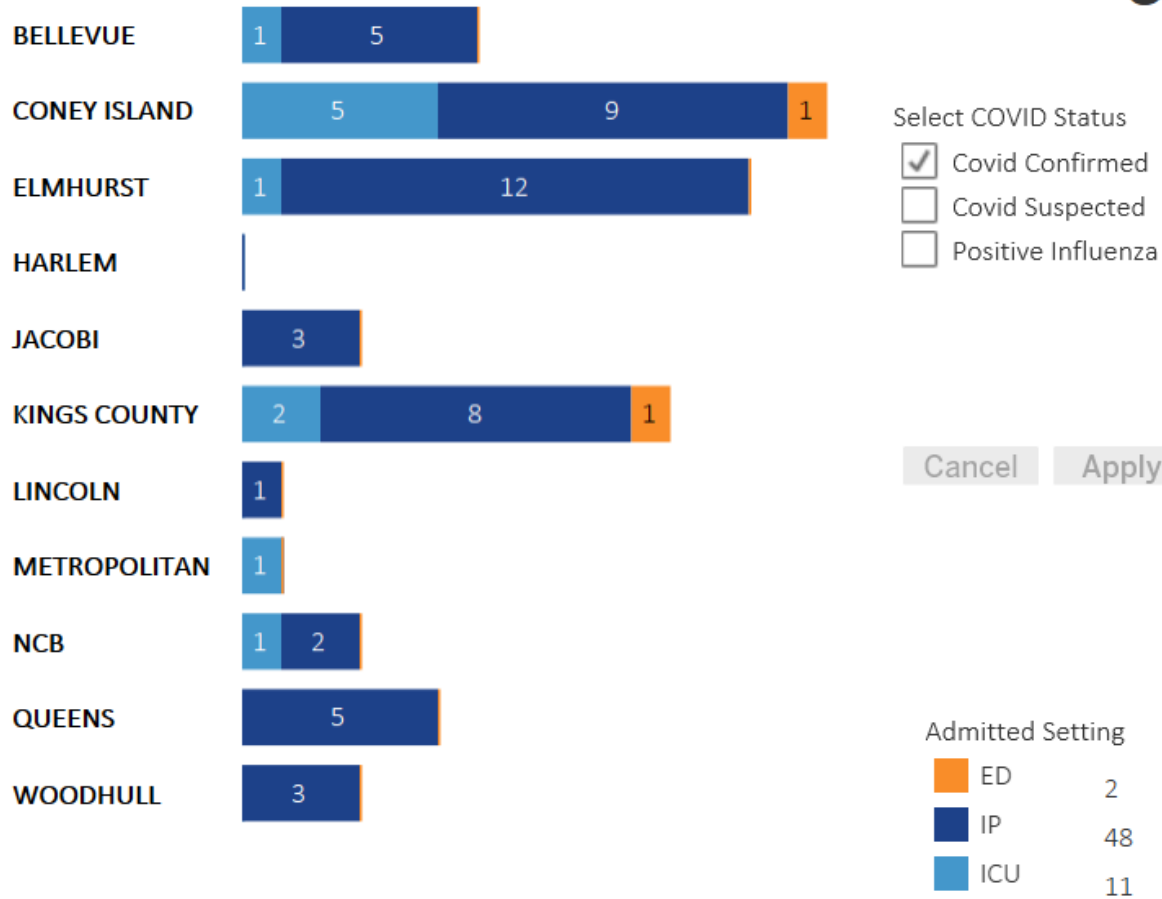

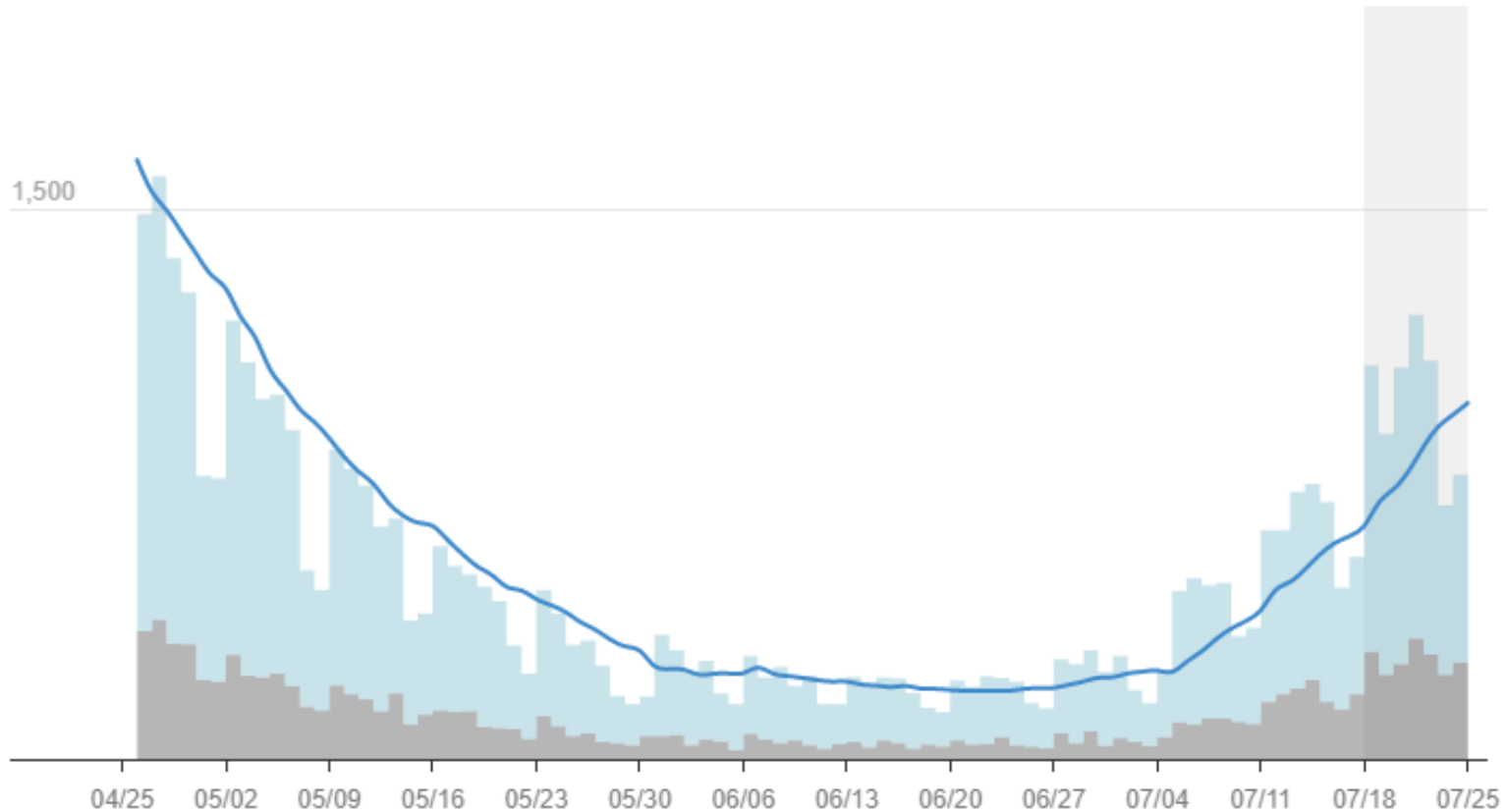

Citywide: cases

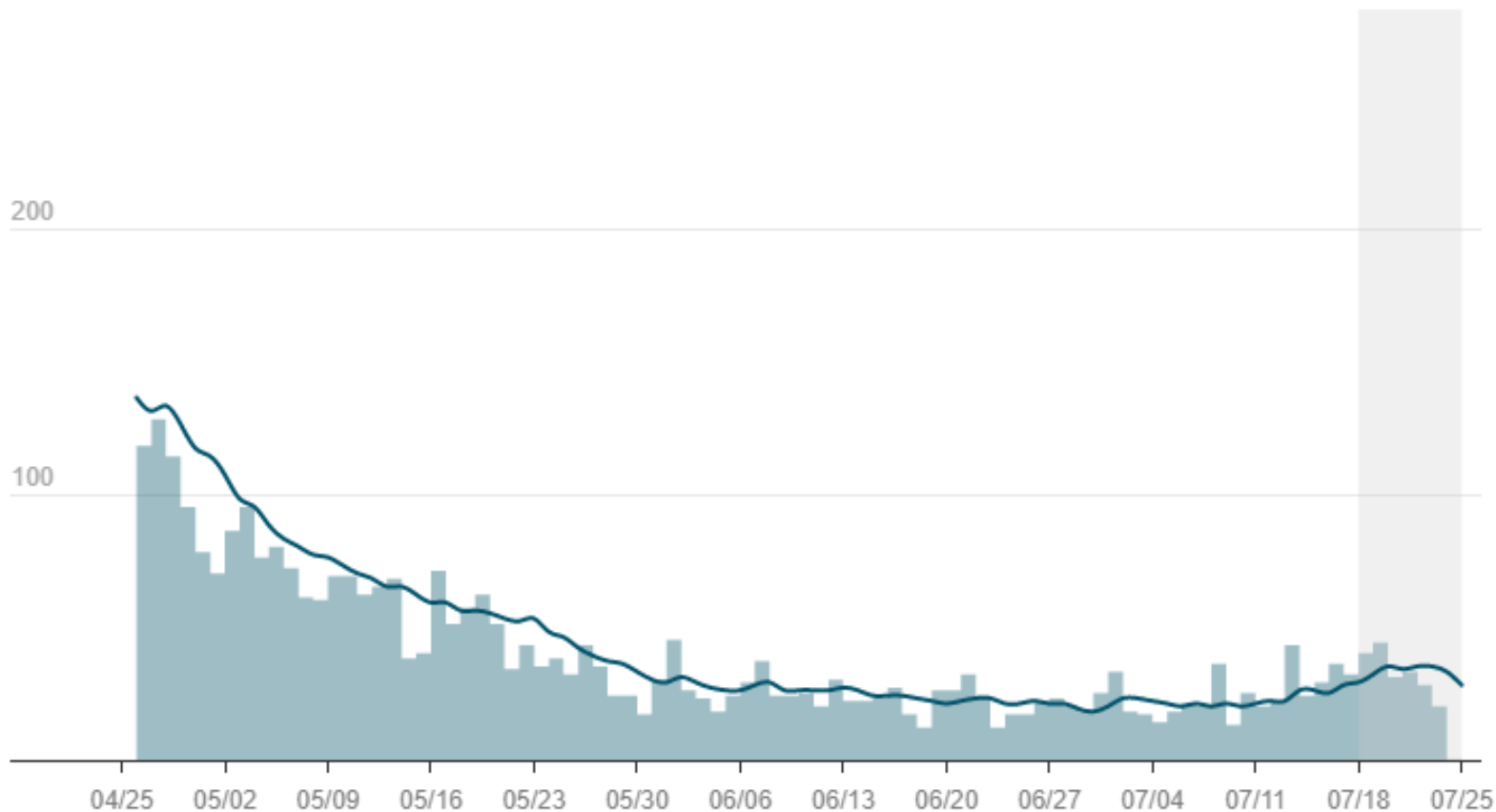

Citywide: hospitalizations

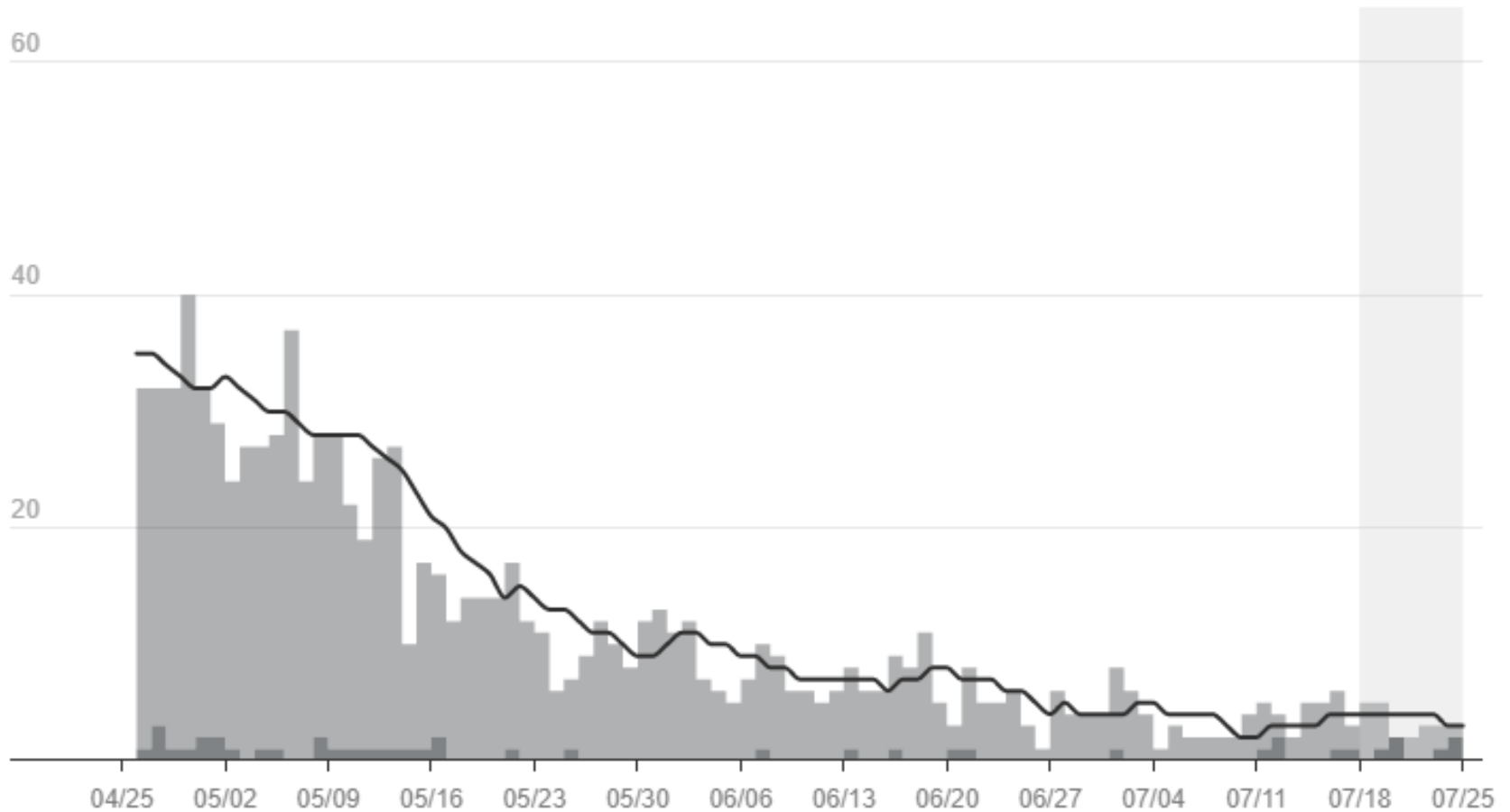

<b>B.1.617.2</b>	<b>Delta</b>	Variant of Concern	 57% of tested cases
<b>B.1.1.7</b>	<b>Alpha</b>	Variant of Concern	 12% of tested cases
<b>B.1.621</b>		Variant of Interest	 7% of tested cases
<b>P.1</b>	<b>Gamma</b>	Variant of Concern	 7% of tested cases

## B.1617.2 (Delta) Variant

- ❑ Initially identified in India in December, 2020
- ❑ First detected in the United States in March, 2021
- ❑ Seems to spread more easily and quickly than other variants
- ❑ Studies suggest that current authorized vaccines work on the circulating delta variant but one must be fully vaccinated
- ❑ Scientists continue to study and learn more

- Adenovector (single dose)

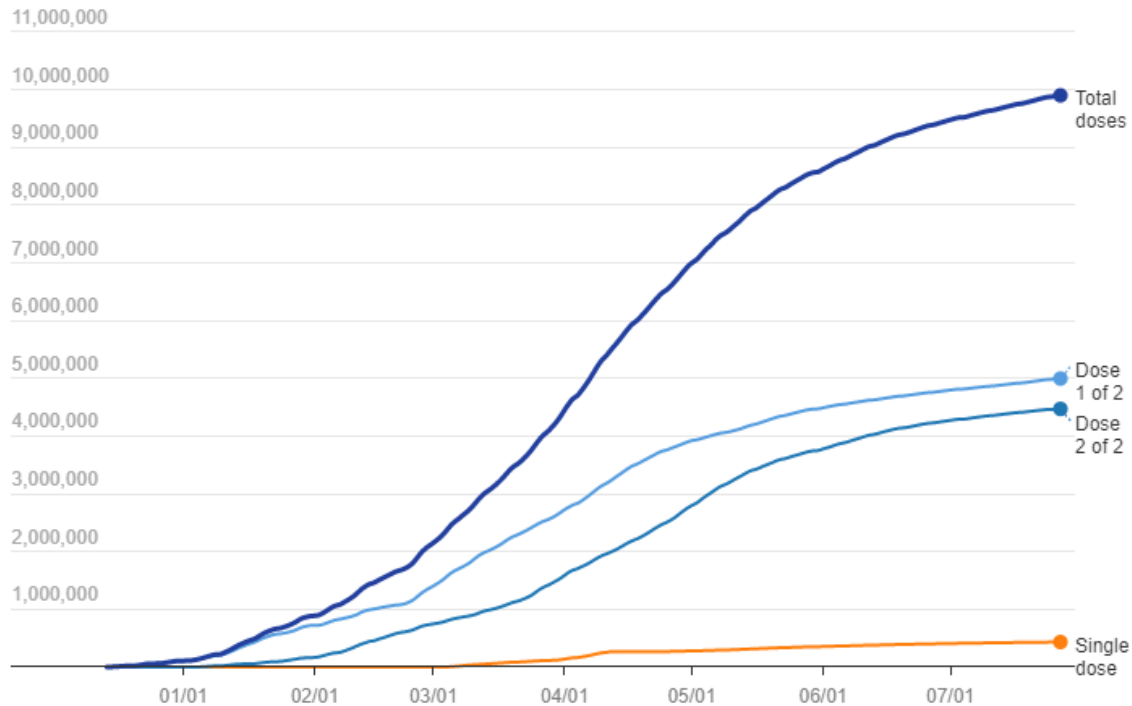

Total number of doses administered in NYC

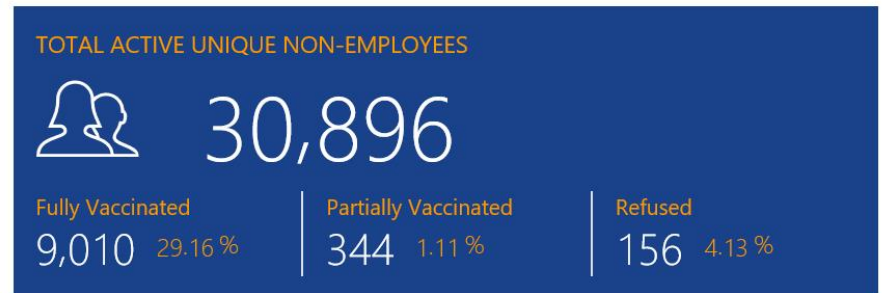

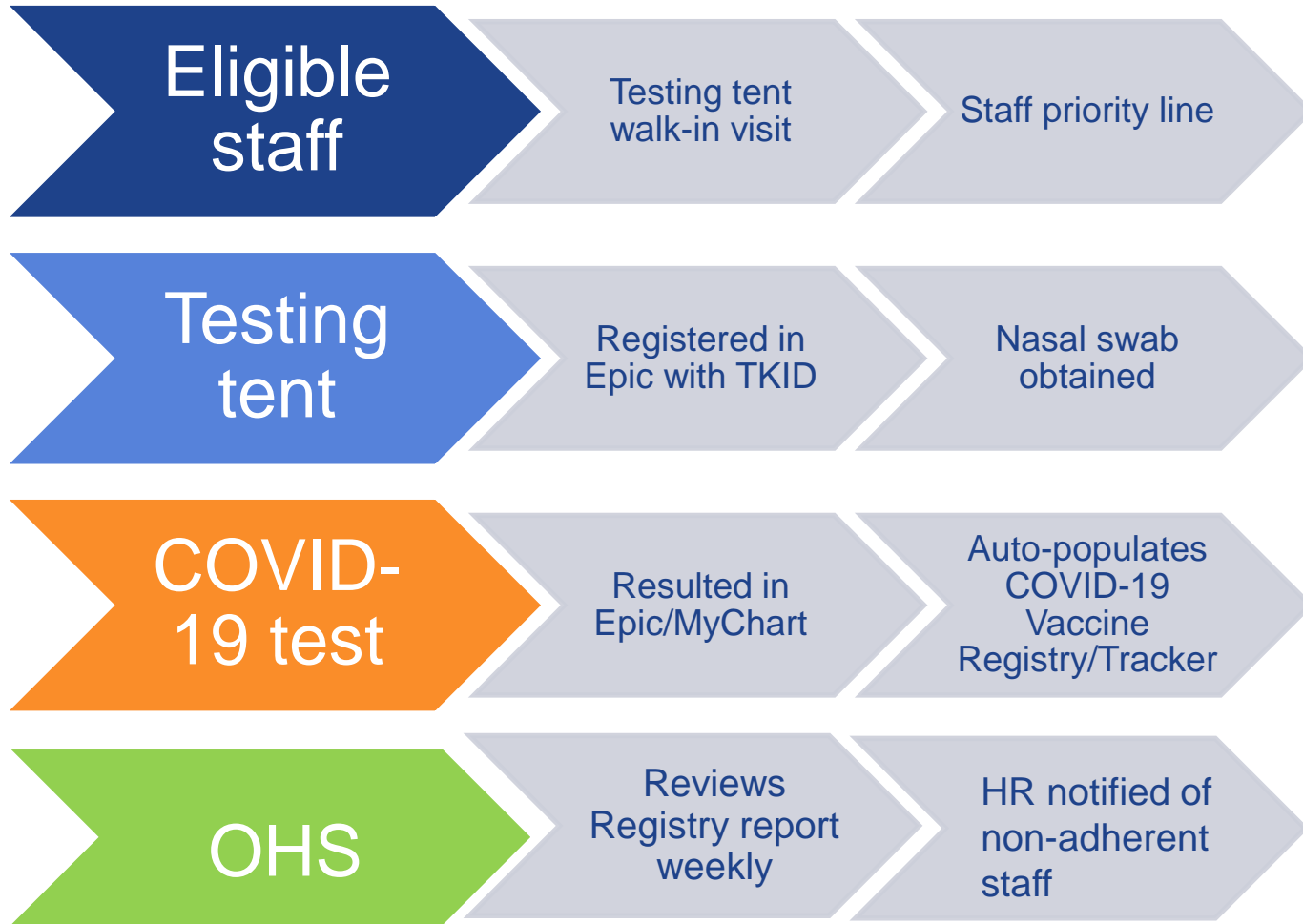

# **\*NEW\* Weekly COVID-19 Workforce Testing**

- Effective Monday, August 2nd
- Expand current framework for offering COVID-19 testing
- Easy access for workforce during work hours in coordination with supervisor
- Create monitoring tools to guide weekly testing progress
- Continue to provide vaccination education

- Eligible employees
  - Unvaccinated
    - NYC Health + Hospitals employees
    - Affiliate employees
    - Medical staff members
    - Students
    - Interns
    - Volunteers
    - Temporary workers
    - Vendor employees
    - Any other staff who may be expected to have recurring interaction/exposure with other staff or patients in any NYC H+H work location
- Weekly measurement period
  - Sunday through Saturday

# Workflow Overview





- ❑ Staff obtaining COVID-19 testing within NYC H+H need not take further action beyond weekly testing
- ❑ Staff obtaining COVID-19 testing outside of NYC H+H will be need to upload results using an app accessible on mobile phone or work station computer OR provide copy to local OHS
- ❑ Tight coordination with OHS and established dashboards will be used for progress monitoring

No cost to employee

- Weekly COVID-19 testing requirement will be defined in an operating procedure and currently in final review
