

HERE'S WHAT HAPPENS AFTER YOUR COVID-19 TEST.







Thank you for taking the first step in keeping yourself, your loved ones and New York City safe.

Below are some next steps you can expect after getting tested.



I'VE TAKEN THE TEST FOR COVID-19. WHAT'S NEXT?

- Fill out the Testing Positive form.
- Most test results come back in 48 hours.
- This information will come from your health practitioner or medical facility.





WHAT IF I TEST POSITIVE?

- A positive diagnosis means you have COVID-19.
- You will have to safely separate at home or in a hotel immediately for 14 days.



I'VE TESTED POSITIVE. WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS?

- Advice and assistance will be provided by your doctor.
- You may get a call from a Contact Tracer to offer help and discuss next steps.
- Together, you will discuss if you need more medical attention.
- If you need to temporarily leave your home to protect those around you, the Contact Tracer will find you a free hotel room where you will receive meals and other support.
- If you can safely stay at home, the Contact Tracer can arrange food and medical deliveries.
- Together you will create a list of everyone you've been in contact with in the days before you became ill.
- The Contact Tracer will then get in touch with them.
 They will encourage them to get tested and safely separate themselves to stop the spread of the virus.
