## **NYC H+H Data 01.21.2021:**

### H+H COVID-19 Intelligence Data Review:

- Our community PCR testing positivity data continues to outpace what is reported for NYC and has dropped over the last week. The 7-day rolling average of all H+H acute sites is 10.32%. Today's percentage is 10.82%.
- Influenza like illness or COVID-like illness in our emergency departments has reached a plateau with today's count at 135.
- COVID-19 admissions reached 404 on January 1<sup>st</sup>. We have seen a decrease for two days, with today's count at 577.
- ICU COVID-19 admissions reached 93 on January 1<sup>st</sup>. The count for today is at 129 with sites reporting manageable strain.
- Bed occupancy numbers have risen slightly with some overcrowding.
- Patient level loading dashboards show signs of strain on some facilities throughout the system. Active patient level loading is successful at relieving the reported strain.
